Who can apply?

Students who at least on the second year (including third year students - provided that the student will be a UW student during the visit)

Important dates

Deadline: **the 24th of February 2017** roku.

Decision: **the 3rd of March 2017**

Documents

- Letter of motivation indicating reasons for the choice of particular institutions together with the applicant's contact details (telephone [very important!], e-mail). In the application please include also all the information that may be important for the selection procedure (participation in classes taught in foreign language, foreign practices, work for the Institute of Philosophy or the University, special academic achievements or honors etc.). If the candidate is considering several possible institutions as possible places for the visit, s/he is asked to indicate his or hers preferences.
- Resume (CV),
- List of all the grades received during the studies at the Institute of Philosophy or during prior studies (if they are not studies at the Institute of Philosophy),
- One opinion (recommendation) of the faculty (teaching) staff member,
- A certificate of language proficiency.
- A personal data form (submitted via e-mail to Anna Szpilowska)

Where to submit?

- Personally to Ms. Anna Szpilowska
- via the correspondence box of Ms. Anna Szpilowska

Criteria

- the grading average obtained from all subjects in Philosophy, cognitive science, bioethics (only students with the average of at least 4.0 may apply);
- other academic achievements;
- the assessment of language proficiency;
- year of study (preference for students of higher years);
- compatibility of student's interests and specialization with the choice of receiving institution;
- work for the Institute of Philosophy or the University.

Language requirements

Determined individually for each partner institution [students are required to check if they are meeting the requirements of the institution they are applying for (e.g. certificates etc.) - they may contact International Relations Office and ask if the institution has such a specific requirements]. Important: the partner universities do not ensure that they will provide the appropriate number of classes taught in the language that is not native (even if the non-native language option is mentioned in the agreement).

For how long?

Monthly scholarship

- a) **500 euro** – Austria, Dania, Finlandia, Francja, Irlandia, Lichtenstein, Norwegia, Szwecja, Wielka Brytania, Włochy;
- b) **450 euro** – Belgia, Chorwacja, Cypr, Czechy, Grecja, Hiszpania, Holandia, Islandia, Luksemburg, Niemcy, Portugalia, Słowenia, Turcja;
- c) **350 euro** – Bułgaria, Estonia, Litwa, Łotwa, Macedonia - była Republika Jugosławii, Malta, Rumunia, Słowacja, Węgry.

Appellation

In case of not being granted with the Erasmus scholarship applicants might lodge an appeal to dr Bogdan Dziobkowski.
